Free Compost

Residents within the Dixon city limits may take up to three yards of free compost from the Hay Road Landfill until October 1, 2004. Just show your identification at the scalehouse. Compost supply is limited.

Heads Up to Landlords

Landlords are urged to check the status of their tenants' garbage bill. Owners are responsible for the payment of the bill. Garbage bills become delinquent after 85 days. Notices of delinquency are sent to property owners and tenants quarterly. Unsettled debts and fees may be placed as liens on the property. Call **DSS** at 678-4026 to check your outstanding balance.
